light colour, pronounced bouquet, verbena, herbs, grapefruit,
powerful wine, taut, lively interaction of fruit and acid, precise,
spicy finish, long-lasting

vintage: 2021

harvest, vinification & origin:

This wine comes from the Zornberg vineyard, which is located directly behind our winery. Here we have three different ages of the vines. The Spitzer Graben gets optimally reflected - good structure with nice acidity from a wine which is storable. Harvest took place in the last week of October and the second week of November. The first part of this wine was fermented in stainless steel tanks, the second part in large wooden barrels. After the fermentation we started to store the wine on the fine lees for about 4 months.
